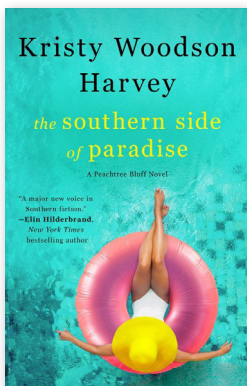


Kristy Woodson Harvey
